HISTORICAL TIMELINE



- 1907** Our great-grandfather, H. Lloyd Miller, pioneered to the northwest settling in Sunnyside, WA
- 1920** H. Lloyd Miller founded our family estate in the heart of the Yakima Valley.
- 1934** H. Lloyd Miller met with President Franklin D. Roosevelt about the Yakima Valley's need for the Roza Irrigation Canal, and the president signed off on the project the following year.
- 1941-1944** Our family property was leased to the Olympia Air Transport Company, and a flight school was established on site. Hundreds of Army Air Corps pilots trained there during World War II.
- 1946** H. Lloyd Miller converted the site of the WWII airbase into his farm headquarters. This marked the beginning of Airport Ranch.
- 1951** With the leadership of H. Lloyd Miller, most of the Roza Irrigation Canal reached completion opening approximately 72,000 acres of farmland to cultivation.
- 1968** Our grandfather Donald Miller planted our first wine grapes consisting of Riesling, Gewürztraminer, and Cabernet Sauvignon.
- 1971** Don Miller plants our first commercial planting of wine grapes making Airport Ranch one of the first commercial growers of wine grapes in Washington State.
- 2005** Airfield Estates Winery was founded by our father Michael Lloyd Miller
- 2007** Airfield wines made their first public debut when we opened our winery and tasting room in Prosser, WA.
- 2010** A second tasting room was opened in Woodinville, WA.
- 2014** A production facility was constructed on our farm capable of crushing up to 1,200 tons of grapes.
